





The meeting ended with a March Trivia contest and 50/50. This months winners were 1st place Joe Sabia and 2nd place Jimmy Hernandez.





APRIL SAFETY ARTICLE

Our riding season is now upon us with the arrival of spring!! Yeah!!! We're all looking forward to our rides and especially the overnighters. As a club your road captains and officers are continually reviewing our safety procedures as we plan rides. Accordingly, we have to be aware that in the event of an incident it is important to know the appropriate medical information about our riders in case a first responder is called to address a situation. As the safety officer I've always asked riders when coming on overnight rides to keep their personal medical information in their wallets in case it's needed. For the record, mine is always in my wallet just in case.

If we are out riding and one of us gets sick or God forbid has an accident, what are the critical items that an attending physician and/or first responder should be aware of? The usual questions are: Any allergies to meds? What kind of meds are you taking and at what frequency? Do you have any medical condition that someone providing emergency care should know about? Who is your ICE (In Case of Emergency) and primary care doctor contact numbers? Get the picture? These questions all need to be answered when the chips are down and you cannot articulate any of this yourself.

Currently we provide a preparation list to all our members prior to an over night ride to ensure that all the necessary must haves are prepared by all the riders for the trip. As a matter of process, we ask all members to add their personal information points, as I mentioned above, and ask that our members have it in their wallet just in case it is ever needed. This personal information will not be asked for or collected by anyone in the club, for your safety we are asking that you have it on your person at all times while riding with us as another component of our club safety rules. Actually, this information is prudent to have on you at all times as it will provide critical information that will be needed to properly administer care in the event of an emergency wherever you may be.

I know, I know what you guys may be thinking.... What a morbid topic for this month's club safety letter Dom. Yes but guess what, if God forbid you ever have an event and this personal information is needed to help you it could wind up saving your life! Not such a bad outcome heh!!

I'll end on a good note: It's finally the beginning of the riding season, prepare your bikes and yourselves for a very fun and active spring, summer and fall. Ride often and above all do it safely.....




