Summer Riding Tips


Our Safety Officer has been very busy traveling all over the country so I am going to take his place. Here are some safety tips to keep our cool while we enjoy the warm weather.

- Resist the urge to shed your riding jacket for your T-shirt, staying covered so you don't get sunburned or lose too much moisture from your skin as sweat quickly evaporates in the wind.
- Chose a textile mesh jacket and pants that are well ventilated to provide airflow and protection. Bright colors make you more visible.
- Opt for a full face well ventilated helmet in a light color.
- Try a cooling vest or a cool wrap soaked in water around your neck.
- Hydrate, water is key to successful summer riding, make regular stops to drink water and bring extra with you. Avoid juices, soda and caffeine.
- Take regular breaks while riding long distances not only for hydration but also to eat to keep your energy up.
- Know the signs of heat exhaustion or heat stroke: fatigue, dizziness, headaches, disorientation, cramps, nausea or heavy sweating.
- Following these easy tips will make our summer riding season safe and fun. Before you know it we will be breaking out our leathers and layers!!
